Our next stop will be India, with a special stop at the Taj Mahal. Then we will move on to Russia to create our own Matryoshka dolls.

Language Arts: sight words: what, out, there, under; word family: -ish (fish, wish etc); phoneme replacement; segmentation, poetry, pronouns

Math: write numerals to 80, simple word problems, graphing, congruent shapes, tally marks, pairs, counting dimes and pennies, simple addition

Social Studies: Asia's land features, landmarks, animals, crops, and culture

Practice at Home

All homework is due on Friday.

For language, your child will trace and write China. Then, they will color the Great Wall of China. A second sheet is attached in which your child will place the names of the food in ABC order and write how many of each food there are.

In math, your child will answer the simple subtraction problems and color the picture to match the code. The second activity requires your child to answer the addition and subtraction problems. Then, they must identify if the letter given represents the first or last sound of the word.

In addition to these pages, please have your child read his/her individual baggie book each night. Also, make a set of sight words for your child and review them nightly. Our sight words this week are : what, out, there, under, and -ish words (fish, wish, etc.).
