Social Studies: the life of Abraham Lincoln including his presidency and influence during the Civil War, Theodore Roosevelt's life, presidency, and legends of compassion.

All homework is due on Friday.

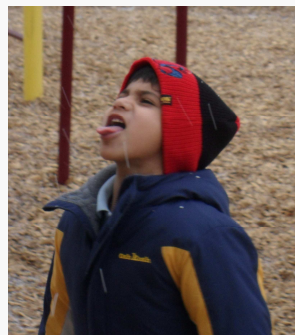
