Date: October 19th - 23rd

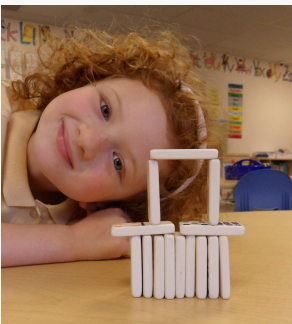
The K2 Preview

We will discover some new vocabulary words along the way like nocturnal, endangered, and echolocation.

Language Arts: site words: blue, away, come, where; individual book All About Bats; word family: -ar (car, far, etc); oral blending and segmentation, rhyming, sensory words, writing cards, comprehension strategy: visualization

Math: writing numerals to 35, simple word problems with number sentences, visual discrimination, patterns, geometric shapes, doubles addition, adding one

Science: bats, bat habitats, bat diets, bat actions
