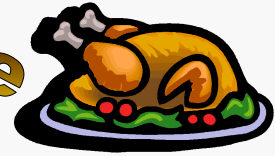




Doyle's Dialogue

Social Studies: Turkey name, size, diet, compare wild and raised turkeys

Practice at Home

In math, your child will read the picture graph about weather and answer the questions. The second activity requires your child to solve simple addition problems using the blackberry pictures.

In addition to these pages, please have your child read his/her individual baggie book each night. Also, make a set of site words for your child and review them nightly. Our site words this week are : Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday, yellow, and -op words (pop, cop).
