## The K2 Preview

"Egg"stra! "Egg"stra! Read all about it! During the next few weeks, we will be investigating eggs. We will learn the parts of an egg, conduct "egg"periments, discover animals that hatch from eggs (oviparous animals), and study the life cycle of these animals. Ask your kindergartener for "egg"citing updates about our studies.

**Language Arts:** sight words: them, after, walk, her; word family: -ice words (dice, rice, etc.); onsets and rimes; dictations, poetry; comprehension strategies: visualizing and asking questions; capital letters

**Math:** writing numerals to 105; solve simple word problems, identify three-dimensional shapes, calendar skills, symbols to compare quantities, sequencing, tally marks, counting mixed groups of coins

**Science:** oviparous animals, life-cycle, parts of the egg, egg-speriments
